

## **Policy Relief for Unemployed CASB Students - Questions and Answers May 2009**

---

- Q1:** Will you be extending the policy relief so I can take more modules without employment?
- A:** We do not have plans to extend the policy relief at this time. CASB learning reinforced by on-the-job training is still a very important element of our program.
- Q2:** If I am not working with a CA Training Office, am I at a disadvantage compared to students who are working?
- A:** Yes, CASB learning is reinforced by on-the-job training.
- Q3:** What if I have a job offer at the end of this module, but am still not employed. Can I register for the next module?
- A:** Yes, prospective students can enroll once in Modules One and Two without being employed and CASB students can enroll once in up to two of the CASB Modules Three, Four and Five.
- Q4:** I am in a module right now and I don't have an employer. If I fail the module I am currently enrolled in, can I retake the module before I find a job?
- A:** Yes if you are an existing CASB student you can retake the module as long as you have only had one other module attempt in modules 3, 4 or 5 while unemployed. If you are prospective student you can retake the module as long as you have only had one other module attempt in modules 1 or 2.
- Q5:** Because I have to pay for the module myself, will you accept deferred payment?
- A:** No, our registration system is not set-up to handle deferred payment.
- Q6:** Is there any change in the required length of service?
- A:** No, all students are still required to completed 30 months of experience at a CA Training Office.
- Q7:** If I pay for the module myself, will I qualify for the Tuition tax Credit?
- A:** Please consult IT516R2 Tuition Tax Credit to determine if you are eligible for the credit.
